	FILL WITH WATER	
	Will straps take weight?	
	Is sprayer stable when filled?	
LEAKAGE CHECK	Check for leaks, upright and on side	
FUNCTION CHECK	Check pressure relief valve to max. limit	
	Spray Out - Is cut-off valve working?	
	Is spray pattern correct?	
	Is nozzle undamaged?	
	Is nozzle flow rate within 5%	
	of manufacturer's stated output?	
INTERNAL RESIDUE	Spray out until fan collapses and air appears	
	Is remaining liquid less than a cupful?	
FOLLOWING USE	Rinse with detergent	
	Rinse twice with water - flush out through lance	
	Clean nozzle and all filters in water with soft brush	
	Clean outside of tank and straps	
	Follow disposal procedure for rinsings
